ALL TEAM MEMBERS AND RESERVES MUST REPORT TO THE REGISTRATION MARQUEE WHICH IS PART OF THE KNOCKOUT ARENA, AT NO LATER THAN **12 noon**. IT IS IMPORTANT THAT TEAMS REGISTER TOGETHER AND ARE **NOT LATE**. THE SHOW RUNS TO A PRECISE SCHEDULE AND THEREFORE WE CANNOT WAIT FOR LATE ARRIVALS.

We aim to provide a full day of fun and excitement for participants, spectators, and organisers alike, however one rule must be observed, please no alcohol before the games, as you would be a danger to yourself and others.

A team consisting of six/eight people and two reserves should be available on the day. Players can be swapped and changed to ensure that no one is left on the sidelines. Team members should be of reasonable fitness and not be undergoing medical treatment or taking prescribed medication. (Please ring if you need anything clarifying.)

Show officials will explain the format of the games and running order on the day along with safety procedures. Please listen carefully to all the instructions given. Six/eight team members will take part in every game. There will be between five and seven games, plus the final if you're that good! You will find out on the day which games you will be playing.

Each team may play a joker which will double their points if they win that particular game. Bonus points are awarded for the team's contribution during the cabaret entertainment spots.

Participants should wear sports clothes i.e. tee shirts, shorts and trainers. A swimming costume should be worn underneath for comfort; tracksuits are advisable, and please remember to bring a TOWEL and a change of clothes and shoes. **YOU WILL GET WET!**

Jewellery may not be worn and there will be no facility for the safekeeping of valuables.

All participants under the age of 16 must have parental consent.

Games List

The number of teams and the time we are given determine the number of games you play. Every team will play at least five of the games listed below. Each game will include either diving through or over a giant inflated obstacle, tip toeing through tropical pools or sliding on a slippery mat. We will bring four giant inflatables each of a different design and each with its own specially designed end backdrop. The games are designed that not just the fastest and fittest over the giant inflatables will always win the game. A little bit of thought and some skill is required for the end backdrops. We also bring a water pool, a slippery mat, and some dinghies! Don't worry there is no danger of drowning; they are pulled along the mat. The arena is spectacular with our vehicles, flags and wonderfully colourful props, staging, sets, and inflatables.

Animal Quakers

Hurry team you must transfer water into the duck pond to save the poor little ducklings.

Turntable!

Can you put the cogs in the right place on the giant board to make the whole thing fit together, turn and get the slider to the bottom to win the game.

Shape Shifter

Make the giant shapes fit the oblong container.

This game also has a twist. The shapes only fit one way.

One in the Eye!

This would definitely make my eyes water. After clambering over the giant inflatable you must now throw the javelin through the giant eye.

Penalty Shootout!

You will slide through the giant inflated tunnels filled with foam and now try to beat the Toulouse le Trec goalie.

The Watering Hole

You can take the water to the Elephant, but can you make him drink?
(Don't forget about the other end of the elephant!! Phew!)

Snakes & Ladders Puzzle

Slide through the tunnels and a nine piece Jigsaw awaits you
Sounds easy, but there's a twist.

Let's SKI if you can do it

Forget snowboarding. Three on one pair of skis is the ultimate buzz as you head down the piste.

Basket Ball Bouncer

Try your hand at being as good as Magic Johnson.

This inflatable stands alone and is a three lane basket ball run.

You slide along on your belly till you reach the bouncing area. Then you bag the ball. EASY!

Jolly Hockey Sticks

You are through the giant squeeze tubes and take up the hockey stick to manoeuvre the puck through the slalom flags and score!

Three in the Sack!

Over the giant inflated wedge and one by one jump into the oversized sack. Once you have three in the sack you must co-ordinate your jumping technique to reach the finishing line.

Hoopla

Through the pool of water. Not too deep but still very very wet!
Practice a game of quoits and you should conquer this game.
