Alabaré Supported Living

Emmaus Community is a place where people with learning difficulties can share life together with mutual relationships and trust in God at the heart of their journey together.

They are a Community of faith, sharing together in prayer and table fellowship on a daily basis.

The homes are places of welcome where people are transformed by an experience of community, relationship, disability and difference.

Mission

To deliver person centred support and accommodation to adults with learning disabilities, enabling inclusion, independence, choice and respect.

Location

Accommodation is provided at a large 6-bedroom house in central Salisbury, and a 5-bedroom detached house in nearby Stratford-sub-Castle. Both are within easy reach of the city centre.

Staff

Trained staff deliver support at both homes and provide sleep over cover at both homes.

Aims

- To enable individuals to develop their daily living domestic and practical skills, supporting individuals to remain safe and secure.
- To enable individuals to build their confidence within the wider community and have the ability to access other agencies and health care.
- To encourage an increased awareness of personal responsibility around safety and security.
- To enable individuals to enjoy, identify and pursue their aspirations through training, education, employment and hobbies thus increasing their confidence and self worth.

Eligibility and referrals

Adults from 18+ with a learning disability. Self referrals or those via social services.

Personal Support Plans

All individuals are allocated a key worker and together agree support plan goals based on a thorough person-centred assessment of their individual needs. Staff also provide emotional support and help signpost and refer to other services and

agencies where necessary.

Individuals can remain living in these houses for as long as the project continues to meet their individual needs, with opportunities move to a house with less support hours if appropriate.

Training and personal development

Support with shopping, budgeting, cooking and hygiene is available and individuals take part in day activities or voluntary/paid employment.

Facilities

The homes are fully furnished and each resident has a bedroom and share the communal kitchen, bathrooms, lounge and dining room. All individuals are encouraged to help with garden maintenance and keeping the house clean.

Funding

Support can be funded by social care, direct payments or individualised budgets or self-funded for support needs. If support needs are funded by social care they may have to pay a contribution. Individuals are supported to apply for housing benefit if eligible and are responsible for paying the weekly accommodation charges.

Tenancies and Support

All individuals are issued with a tenancy agreement which is separate to the support they receive, the support is not tied to the accommodation and so the person can move to another home and/or to another support provider if they wish to.

Equal opportunities and confidentiality

Alabaré believes in equal opportunities and will not discriminate against service users on any basis. All information about services users is regarded as confidential and safeguarded.
