If it hadn't been for one man, Bob, Alabaré would never have been. Bob was homeless and an alcoholic, with nowhere left to turn. John and Alicia Proctor and their small Christian Community were asked if they would help, and despite some misgivings they took Bob in. Two, occasionally rocky, years later, Bob successfully moved on to a treatment centre and was almost immediately replaced by Mary, a young pregnant lady whose husband was in prison.

John and Alicia recognised that there was an urgent need for a dedicated home for people who were vulnerable and homeless. They launched a local fundraising

appeal and in 1991 Alabaré Christian Care Centres was born.

Our charity has grown to provide **specialist homes, support and training** for people who are homeless, including young people and those leaving care, young mothers and their babies, Veterans and those suffering from addictions and mental ill-health. We also run long term homes for adults who have Learning Disabilities, as well as providing activities and training courses.

Our doors are open to those of all faiths or none, and our values of Care, Compassion, Generosity and Respect are drawn from our Christian heritage.



Over the last 25 years, Alabaré's dedicated staff and volunteers have helped transform thousands of lives, giving each person the opportunity to live a fulfilling life.

Preventing Homelessness

We provide a range of homes and services which help people move from the crisis of homelessness to the security of their own home.

Our Drop In Centres provide day time shelter for those living on the streets or in temporary accommodation. We offer hot meals, clothing, toiletries and washing facilities. Our team are on hand to give non-judgmental advice and practical help with claiming benefits and accessing housing.

Supported Housing

Each of our homes provides a warm and welcoming environment for people who have been living in crisis. Our teams of staff and volunteers help residents confront the problems that have led to their becoming homeless, and are there to give practical and emotional support.



We will help residents find out about employment and training opportunities, as well as leisure activities happening in their local communities. Together we will develop a plan to help each person move on to the life they aspire to.

Move On

Our Move On homes are a stepping stone in accommodation towards independent living. Residents can still access support, but benefit from managing their own wellbeing on a day to day basis.

Homes for Veterans

In 2009 we identified that a significant number of Armed Forces Veterans were using our homeless services. We recognised that they would benefit from a dedicated programme of accommodation, support and understanding to help them cope with civilian life. We now have homes across South West England and Wales and are working in partnership with many military charities to ensure that our Veterans can access the support they need.

Young People

Our Supported Housing provides accommodation and support for homeless young people and care leavers.

Mother & Baby Homes support young mums and mums-to-be, enabling them to learn the skills they need to live independently and look after their child.

The Andover Foyer is an integrated learning and accommodation service for 16-21 year-olds. It includes a Drop In Centre providing advice and training and an arts & music programme.

Learning Disability Services

Supported Living offers long-term accommodation and support with everyday tasks. We encourage residents to pursue their own goals and take part in leisure activities and outings.

Alabaré Home & Community is our domiciliary care service for people with a learning disability and/or mental health needs who live in their own home.

Development Centres offer a range of activities and courses such as cookery, crafts, woodwork, horticulture and pottery.
