

The Wiltshire Foyer

Devizes, Trowbridge, Chippenham & Salisbury

Wiltshire Foyer is a supported housing project with small homely properties across Wiltshire totalling 35 Beds.

Mission

To provide accommodation for 35 young people with medium to high support needs in a supportive, stimulating and safe environment, enabling them to make life changes and develop so that they are able to move on into successful independent living.

Location

Our properties are all located within walking distance of town centres, leisure facilities and colleges.

Training courses are available in house through our Training and Development Team – Alabare Academy and all residents undertake Tenancy Training prior to Move On to their own accommodation,

We have good relationships with other partner agencies that can offer support across a wide range of support needs Staff

Our properties have access to staff 9-5 Monday to Friday with staff also visiting the property over weekends. There is an on call service between the hours of 5pm and 9am (including weekends and bank holidays). Alabare has been an Investor in People since 2001.

Aims

- To provide a safe place for young people to live, learn and make the transition to independent adulthood.
- To enable service users to build constructive and positive relationships within the community.
- To encourage an awareness of personal responsibility around safety and security.
- To enable service users to enjoy, identify and pursue their aspirations through training, education, employment and hobbies thus increasing their confidence and self worth.
- To increase awareness around physical and mental wellbeing and enable service users to access health services.

Eligibility and referrals

Referrals are accepted through Wiltshire local housing department at Bourne Hill, Salisbury, County hall, Trowbridge and Monkton Park, Chippenham.

All applications must be for young people aged 16-25 years.

Personal Support Plans

All residents are allocated a key worker and together agree a support plan based on a thorough assessment of their individual needs. Staff signpost residents to appropriate agencies.

Length of stay

Maximum stay is 2 years, average stay is 12 months.

Facilities

All properties have shared communal facilities with some properties having en-suites.

Policies

- No smoking in the project
- Projects are dry, no alcohol allowed
- We have a no drugs tolerance policy including legal highs
- 24 hour residents access
- Visitors permitted between 9am and 10pm
- Complaints/Harassment procedure for residents
- Funding and external reviews
- This project is funded by the Local Authority and payment of rent.
