

# Supported Housing South (other homes)

**Alabaré Supported Housing South provides accommodation in South Wiltshire for service users requiring a high, medium and low levels of support. Our high support accommodation is available through Alabaré Place and Barnabas House, with additional low and medium support housing provided in smaller homes around Salisbury.**

## **Mission (other homes)**

To provide accommodation for 64 people with low to medium support needs in a supportive, stimulating and safe environment enabling them to make life changes and develop appropriate skills to live independently.

## **Location**

The accommodation is spread throughout Salisbury and consists of four 3-bed houses, one 2-bed house, plus 5 beds of a larger 9-bedded house.

## **Staff**

Visiting support is offered during office hours although exceptions can be made for clients who work. Alabaré has been an Investor in People since 2001.

## **Aims**

- To enable service users to have the skills and confidence to move on to independent accommodation.
- To enable service users to build constructive and positive relationships within the community.
- To encourage an awareness of personal responsibility around safety and security.
- To enable service users to enjoy, identify and pursue their aspirations through training, education, employment and hobbies thus increasing their confidence and self worth.
- To increase awareness around physical and mental wellbeing and enable service users to access health services.

## **Eligibility and referrals**

Referrals are accepted from other Alabaré projects or via Wiltshire Council Housing Options Team if there is a room available. If there is a waiting list for places we operate a points system. Referrals must be low to medium support needs.

## **Personal Action Plans**

All residents are allocated a key worker and together agree an action plan based on a thorough assessment of their individual needs. Staff signpost residents to appropriate agencies.

## **Length of stay**

The maximum stay is two years.

## **Facilities**

All our properties come fully furnished to a high standard and we also supply bedding, kitchen utensils and crockery.

## **Training**

Tenancy skills training is available and further training opportunities are available through Wiltshire College. All service users are able to access the facilities at Alabaré Place.

## **Policies**

- Licence agreement to be signed on acceptance.
- 24 hour residents access
- No overnight guests
- Suggestions are welcomed. Complaints procedure is available to residents.

## **Equal opportunities and confidentiality**
