

# Salisbury Street Project

## Mission

The Salisbury Street Project is our Drop In Centre which provides a warm and welcoming environment for people who are street homeless and in need of shelter, hot food, drinks and practical assistance.

The centre is aimed at people over the age of 16 who are homeless. Some clients may have issues such as debt, mental health problems, substance misuse, alcohol dependency or poor life skills.

## Location

The Salisbury Street Project is based at Alabaré Place in Salisbury; it has full wheelchair access and adapted facilities for people with disabilities.

## Staff

There is a team of staff and volunteers on hand to offer support and signposting to specialist agencies. Alabaré has been an Investor in People since 2001.

## Aims

- To maintain the basic health and well-being of people who are homeless or facing homelessness.
- To provide information and to be a point of contact for the homeless and services that can support and assist them.
- To alleviate the social isolation experienced by many homeless and vulnerable people.
- To develop the self confidence and capabilities of individuals so that they can participate in their local community.

## Eligibility

You must be 16 or over to use the Centre.

## Assessment of Needs

All service users undergo an initial needs assessment when visiting the centre.

## The Centre provides:

- Hot drinks, cereal and toast in the morning
- Freshly prepared hot meals at lunchtime.
- Access to basic items of clothing, toiletries and sleeping bags
- Laundry and washing facilities.
- A postal address.
- Information, advice and support for individuals with housing and welfare benefit issues.

## Policies

- No alcohol or drugs allowed on the premises.
- Dogs are welcome.

## Funding

All funding for this service comes from Alabaré's fundraising activities.
