



### Terms and Conditions of Entry:

Glow in the Park is a trading name of Votwo Events Limited. Registered in England and Wales No: 5986260. Registered Address: Votwo Events, Unit 10, Kings Farm Rural Workshops, Everton Road, Hordle SO41 0HD.

Alabaré Christian Care & Support 2 Watt Road · Churchfields · Salisbury SP2 7UD. Registered Charity No. 1006504.

The homeless charity, Alabaré Christian Care & Support is the Event promoter and will use the income generated to help end homelessness.

Votwo Events and Alabaré in these terms and conditions are called the “Event Organisers”

These terms and conditions apply to all participants take part in Glow in the Park: Longleat. In these terms and conditions participants will also be referred to as “you”.

### By participating in the event you are agreeing to be bound by these terms and conditions:

1. All participants must be above 6 years of age by 7th September 2019. All participants aged 18 and under must be accompanied by a paying adult at all times.
2. This event is not suitable for pushchairs.
3. Please note that the UV paint used in the Paint Zone advises that children under the age of 7 do not touch the paint. If your child is under the age of 7 they must use the route around this zone. If you and your child decide to go through this zone it is at your own risk
4. You are responsible for reading the details and description regarding the event contained on the website [www.glowinthepark.co.uk](http://www.glowinthepark.co.uk) and any other information that may be sent to you by the Event Organisers and agree that you clearly understand what ability is required and what is entailed in participating in the event. The event is a fun run held at night in the dark. Some areas/zone are lit but the majority of the course is in the dark. Paths, tracks, and grass surfaces are used for the course and there might be some natural undulations in the ground and some broken surfaces underfoot. You must wear a working head torch when taking part in the event and agree on maintaining a vigilant observation of the path in front of you
5. The registration fee must be paid in full at the time of registration. No refunds will be made or offered
6. Entries can be transferred to another participant. Please make sure that the online form is filled out for the new participant. You do not need to email us about this
7. The Event Organisers reserve the right to cancel your participation in the event if any information provided by you is found to be inaccurate in any way. In this case, you will be refunded your entry fee minus 20% administration costs

8. Please note that all arrangements for the event, including the venue, date, and program may be subject to change
9. You are responsible for ensuring that you have taken your own medical advice and that you are medically fit and healthy to participate in the event
10. You are responsible for taking out suitable personal insurance cover for your participation in the event, and you must provide a copy of your insurance certificate to the Event Organizers if requested
11. You agree that you participate in the event at your own risk, and accept that the Event Organisers cannot be liable to the fullest extent permitted by law, for any personal injury sustained by you in any way or loss or damage to any personal property as a result of your participation in the event
12. You must abide by any rules or regulations of the Event that may be notified to you by the Event Organisers or Longleat at any point leading up to or at the event
13. You must show respect and courtesy towards other participants and spectators. If you behave in any manner which is, in the Event Organisers opinion, poor sportsmanship or a risk to the safety of any other participant, spectators or anyone else in attendance at the event this may result in you being asked to leave the venue
14. You are responsible for the safekeeping of your own personal possessions and those of any spectators you may bring to the event. Personal possessions left unattended at Longleat in any facilities provided or otherwise are left entirely at your own risk
15. The Event Organisers are not responsible for any third party organisations that may be providing other services at the event. You use any such services at your own risk
16. If access to published course is restricted for any reason an alternative route will be used
17. If the event has to be postponed or cancelled for any reason, the Event Organisers will endeavour to arrange an alternative event, and you will be notified of the new date and venue of the rearranged event. These terms and conditions will continue to apply to the rearranged event. No refund will be given if you do not wish to participate in the rearranged event. Travel fees will not be refunded if the event is re-scheduled. If the event is cancelled the Event Organizers shall not be liable for any costs, losses or damages incurred by you. There is no refund of entry fees
18. You agree to photographs and video being taken at the event and that any images of you may be used by the Event Organisers in any media regarding the event and to market and advertise the event or any other similar events
19. By Registering you are agreeing to any data provided being used by the event organisers Alabaré, Votwo, Glow in the Park, and Longleat Enterprises Ltd to process your participation in the event and send you details only regarding the Glow in the Park: Longleat event. We would like to keep you up to date on news and offers, to receive this information you must tick the opt-in button on the purchase page. We will all abide by the Data Protection Act.

21. This event is not suitable for anyone that suffers from any conditions induced by bright, flashing lights or loud music

## Terms and Conditions of the Longleat Roar Package

What you need to know:

- The run will begin at 8.15pm, however, there are warm up sessions from 7:30pm that we recommend all participants take part in.
- The event is open to people of all ages and abilities but some people may find large crowds overwhelming. Children aged 7 and under can have a ball dancing around the UV Paint Blast Zone.
- The Longleat Roar package allows you to enter Longleat from 10am and access the Safari Drive-through, attractions and animal areas.
- Attractions open until 7:30pm include Rockin' Rhino, King Arthur's Mirror Maze, Family Bygones, Little Explorer's Garden, Adventure Castle and Hedge Maze.
- Animal areas open until 7pm include the Bat Cave, Jungle Kingdom, Animal Adventure, Jungle Cruise and Monkey Temple.
- Anyone buying the Longleat Roar package will be sent a voucher for the meal and drink which are valid to redeem in The Chameleon Tree Restaurant, Pizza Piazza or Main Square Kiosks between 10am & 8pm.
- All participating children must be accompanied by a participating adult and cannot run alone.
- Entry to Longleat is only valid on the 7th September 2019.
- Child rates apply to children aged 3-15 years (we advise that this event is suitable for children aged 6 years plus, due to the size of the crowds.)
- If you are an Annual Pass holder you are welcome to visit Longleat at any time during opening hours but the Glow Run is not included with your Annual Pass.
- Spectators coming in before 7pm will be required to purchase a Day Ticket to Longleat.
- Spectators coming in after 7pm will have free entry to watch the event.
- There will be no entry to the Park from 7.45pm.
- Dogs and all other pets are not permitted into any of the attractions (not applicable to Service Dogs although restrictions do apply). Please see Longleat's website for their Accessibility Policy for full information.
- Longleat reserves the right to close to the public, withdraw any attraction, alter times, prices and events or services without notice.
- Longleat reserves the right to refuse entry.
